Spinal Decompression Therapy

In the past, Doctors have been restricted to treating back problems with surgery, pain medications, physical therapy, and spinal manipulation. Complications from surgery have been shown to be expensive and risky and recovery can last for months. But thousands of lower back and neck pain patients have been successfully treated by spinal decompression therapy without surgery or injections.

What is Non-Surgical Spinal Decompression Therapy?

Spinal Decompression Therapy is a non-drug, non-surgical, FDA cleared treatment that helps reduce or eliminate painful herniated, degenerated and bulging discs in the lower back and neck. It's an amazing healthcare breakthrough providing an 86% success rate. The therapy is focused on decompressing the discs. When a disc is "decompressed" negative pressure is created within the disc, which allows for the re-introduction of water, oxygen, and nutrients into the disc which heals the disc from the inside out. Decompression decreases the pressure within a damaged disc allowing the disc to re-hydrate which restores the normal height to the disc and reduces the irritation associated with the damaged disc.

Spinal Decompression Therapy is administered by a state of the art FDA cleared decompression machine.
